COOKIE POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This Cookie Policy explains how Fast Ledger Limited ("Fast Ledger", "we", "us" or "our"), registered at Unit 30 The Business Village, Wexham Road, Slough, England, SL2 5HF, uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on our website at fastledger.info and within our Platform. This policy should be read alongside our Privacy Policy, which governs the broader processing of your personal data.

1.2 Cookies are small text files placed on your device by a website or online service. They serve a variety of functions, including enabling websites to function correctly, remembering your preferences, and providing analytics to help us understand how our Platform is used. Similar technologies, including web beacons, pixel tags, session tokens and local storage objects, may also be used for similar purposes and are referred to collectively in this Policy as "cookies".

1.3 Our use of cookies is governed by the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 ("PECR"), the UK GDPR, and, in respect of Spanish Users, by the applicable requirements of the LOPDGDD and Ley 34/2002 (LSSI). Under these laws, we are required to obtain your consent before placing non-essential cookies on your device.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

2.1 **Strictly Necessary Cookies.** These cookies are essential for the Platform to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. They are set only in response to actions made by you, such as logging in, setting your privacy preferences or completing a form. They do not store any personal data and are not used for marketing. As these cookies are essential, they do not require your consent. Examples include: session authentication cookies; CSRF (cross-site request forgery) protection tokens; and load balancing session cookies.

2.2 **Functional Cookies.** These cookies enable the Platform to remember choices you make and provide enhanced, personalised features. For example, they may remember your display preferences, language settings and last active session state. These cookies do not track your browsing activity on external websites. They require your consent before being placed.

2.3 **Analytics and Performance Cookies.** These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our Platform. They help us understand which pages are most and least popular and how visitors interact with the Platform. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know when you have visited our Platform. They require your consent before being placed.

2.4 We do not currently use advertising, targeting or third-party marketing cookies. Fast Ledger is a business-to-business platform and does not engage in behavioural advertising.

3. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

3.1 Some cookies placed on our website or Platform are set by third parties. These may include analytics providers, security providers and embedded content or tool providers. Where such third-party cookies are non-essential, we will seek your consent before they are placed.

3.2 We do not control the cookies placed by third parties and are not responsible for the content of third-party privacy policies. You should review the privacy and cookie policies of any third-party service accessible from our Platform.

4. COOKIE CONSENT AND HOW TO MANAGE YOUR PREFERENCES

4.1 When you first access our website or Platform, you will be presented with a cookie consent banner through which you may accept or decline non-essential cookies. You may update your preferences at any time by accessing the cookie settings within your Platform account or by re-engaging the consent banner on our website.

4.2 You can also control and delete cookies through your browser settings. Most browsers allow you to: view the cookies stored on your device; delete some or all cookies; block cookies from specific websites; and block all cookies. Please note that if you delete or block essential cookies, some or all of the Platform's functionality may be impaired or unavailable.

4.3 For guidance on managing cookies within your specific browser, please refer to the help documentation provided by your browser developer. Commonly used browsers include Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, Microsoft Edge and Opera.

4.4 Spanish Users may also manage cookie preferences in accordance with the guidance provided by the AEPD (aepd.es) regarding consent to cookies under Spanish law.

5. RETENTION OF COOKIE DATA

5.1 The retention period for each cookie depends on whether it is a session cookie or a persistent cookie. Session cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser. Persistent cookies remain on your device for the period specified in the cookie or until you delete them manually. We do not retain cookie data beyond what is necessary for the purpose for which it was placed.

6. CHANGES TO THIS COOKIE POLICY

6.1 We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in technology, law or our business practices. Where material changes are made, we will notify you by posting a prominent notice on our website or by email prior to the change taking effect. Your continued use of the Platform after the effective date of any change constitutes your acceptance of the revised Cookie Policy.
